The farm has a network of footpaths, cycle ways and bridleways providing ample opportunity to explore our local countryside.

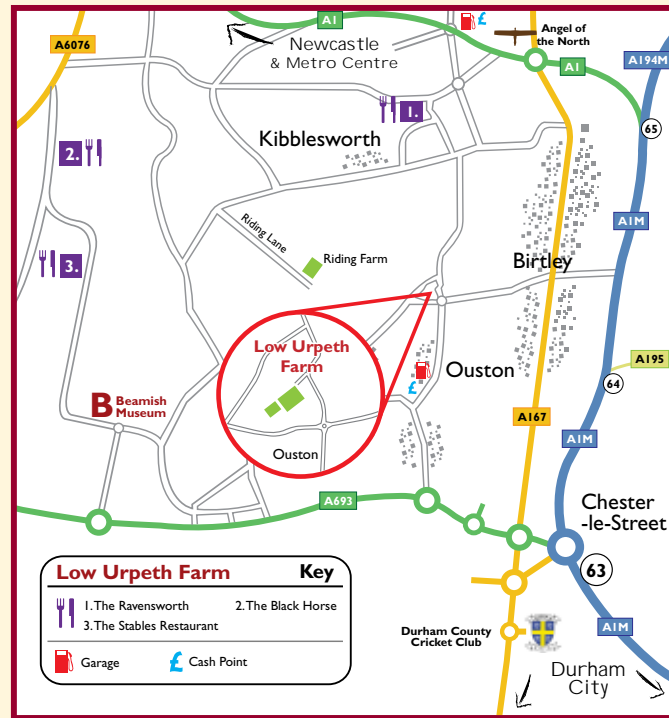


DIRECTIONS

Low Urpeth Farm Bed & Breakfast/Self Catering cottages are easily accessible from the AIM between Newcastle and Durham, leaving AIM at Chester-le-Street, junction 63.

Follow signs for Beamish Museum on the A693 (1.5 miles), at the 3rd roundabout turn right to Ouston. Continue through the village of Ouston passing the garage on your left. On Leaving Ouston, **go straight on at the roundabout** (sign-posted Lamesley) and take the first left at the bottom of the hill into 'Low Urpeth Farm'. There is ample parking.

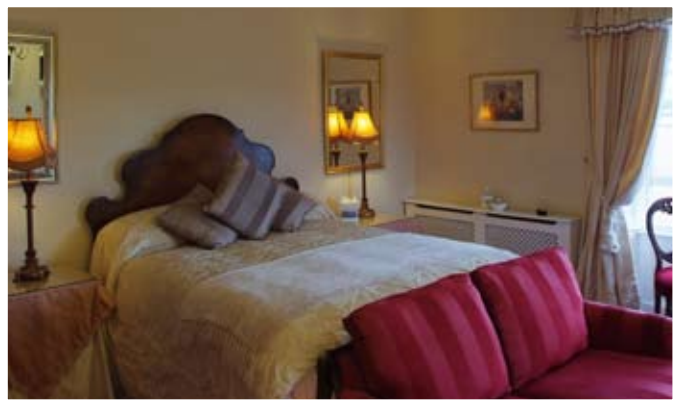
